**Ordinance 679**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SISSETON, ROBERTS COUNTY, SOUTH DAKOTA, that

Pursuant to Sisseton, SD Municipal Code Chapter 1.12 – City Wards and Precincts, Section 1.12.010 – Ward Boundaries, it would be in the best interest of the City of Sisseton if the Voting Wards were amended to provide a more equitable distribution of voters based upon race and population. The redistricting determined by the 2020 Census would provide each Ward with approximately the following number of persons:

Ward One	830 persons
Ward Two	787 persons
Ward Three	862 persons

A map illustrating the division of Wards is attached as Exhibit A.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from twenty (20) days after the date of the final passage and adoption.

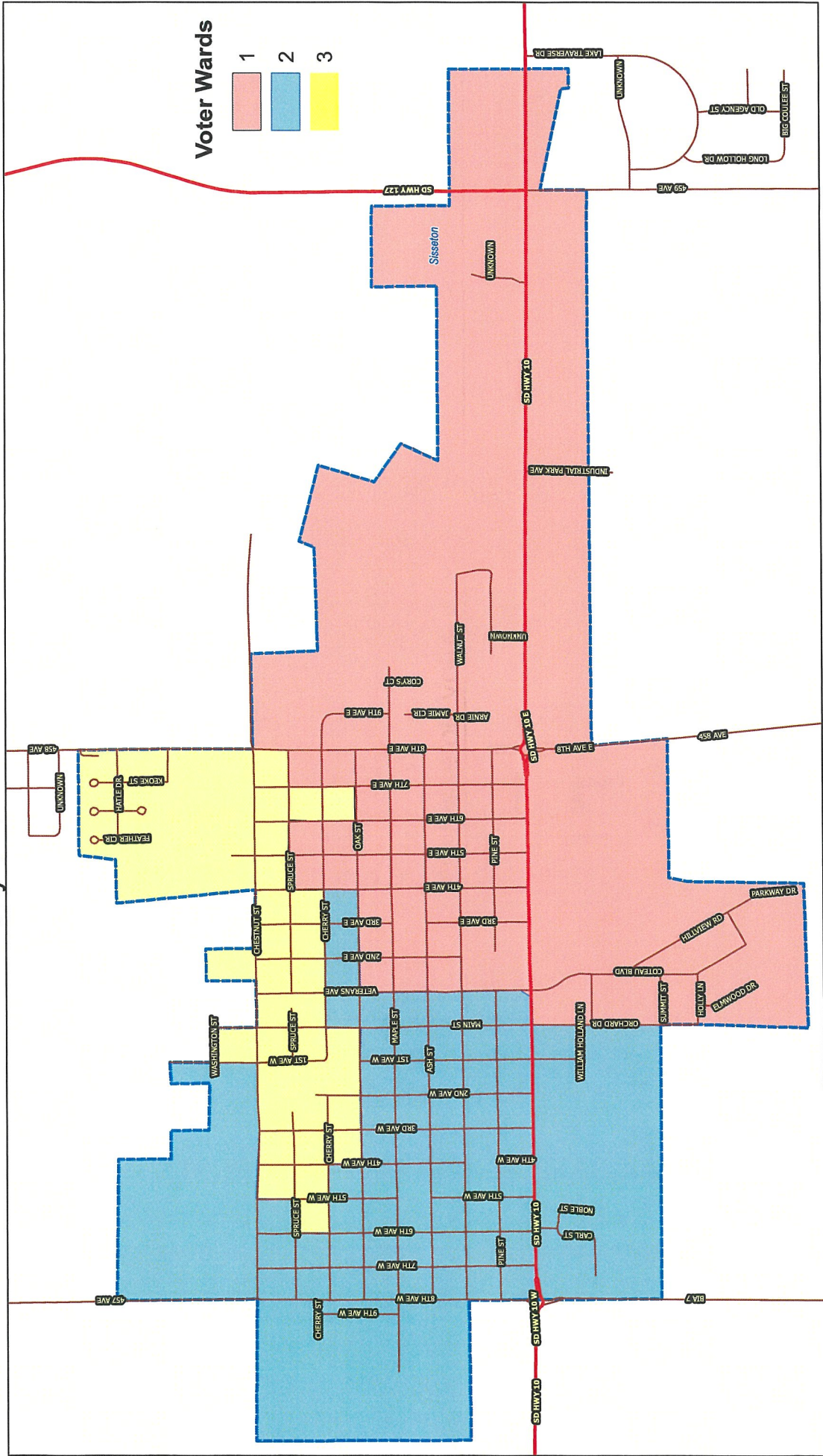
