

The City Council for the City of Sisseton met in joint special session with the Sisseton Planning Commission on Monday, June 7, 2021 at 7:00 p.m.

City Council Members Present: Mayor Terry Jaspers, Alderwoman Randolph, Aldermen Just, Solberg and Stapleton. Alderwoman Appel and Alderman German were absent.

Planning Commission Members Present: President Cory Deutsch, Larry Peterson, Samantha Stickland and Wade Veflin.

Others Present: Erin Cameron, Amber Kemnitz, Jim Croymans, Jason Deutsch, Richard TallBear

Call to Order: Mayor Jaspers called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

Agenda: Randolph moved and Solberg seconded to approve agenda as presented. All voted aye.

Convene as City Council & Planning Commission: Stapleton moved and Solberg seconded to convene jointly as City Council and Planning Commission to conduct a Public Hearing to consider ordinance 672.

Planning Commission Recommendation to Pass Ordinance 672: Peterson moved and Stickland seconded to recommend approval of temporary ordinance 672.

Public Hearing: Mayor Jaspers opened the public hearing to allow comment from the public on proposed ordinance 672.

Richard TallBear addressed Council regarding allowing medical marijuana facilities prior to the State establishing regulations in order to allow opportunity for economic growth.

Attorney Cameron advised passing the temporary ordinance to allow time for City to determine zoning regulations.

Public hearing is closed.

Upon roll call vote of the Planning Commission, voting aye were Deutsch, Peterson, Stickland and Veflin. Motion carried.

Ordinance 672: Solberg moved and Stapleton seconded to pass the first reading of Ordinance 672 - A temporary ordinance regarding the issuance of local medical cannabis establishments permits and/or licenses. Upon roll call vote, voting aye were Just, Stapleton, Solberg and Randolph. Appel and German were absent. Motion carried.

Adjourn as Joint Commission: Deutsch moved and Peterson seconded to adjourn as a joint City Council and Planning Commission. All voted aye.

Adjourn: Just moved and Randolph seconded to adjourn. All voted aye. Meeting adjourned at 7:20 p.m.
